The D Café goes from strength to strength we had twice the number at the second meeting as the first, as you will see in a later article in this edition.



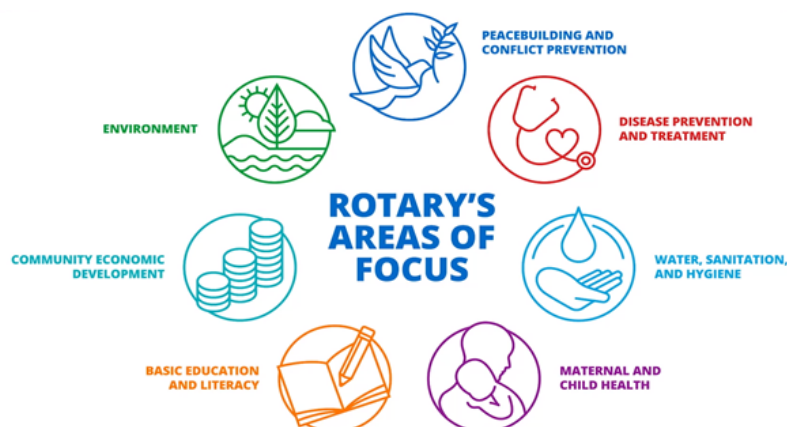

Please do not forget to register for the District Conference on the 13<sup>th</sup> March, which is free so you can see how our wonderful video does in the competition.

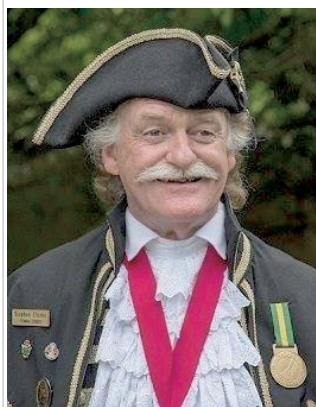

## forget me not Café

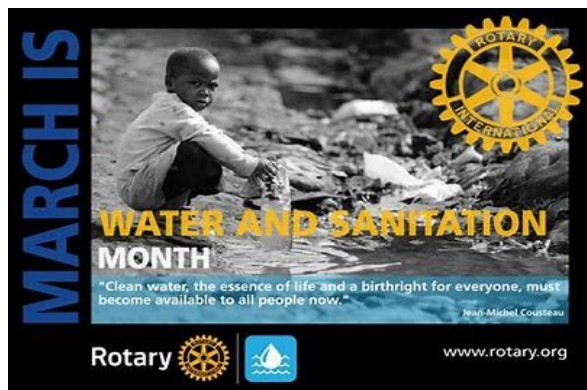
Forget Me Not café will be
